

Webmaster Report for www.scochr.org
March 2008

This site was set up and the domain name was paid for by the SC OCR. The domain name has been paid through April 2012.

President Andrea Wolfe appointed Anne Gelwicks as Webmaster.

The Webmaster will make single web pages for any chapter who requests it and furnish all the information that they want on the page. It is not intended that these pages change often.

Events to be added to the state calendar page must have a link to another website or an email address for further information. Since pages will only be updated about once a month, event info should be sent in well in advance of the event date. Since the Webmaster receives many event notices from unfamiliar email addresses, please state that in your message if you want the event added to the calendar.

Last Fall, the company that furnishes our free webspace moved all of our files to a new server. It is very different from our old one and there have been glitches to work out. The "permissions" problems have been resolved and all the folders are in the correct place. There are two items that resulted in changes.

First of all, the new server doesn't accept "sub webs" at this time. To work around this, I have moved our "sub webs" for Snowden, Salt Ketchers and Wild Rose. They are now webpages on the main site. I removed some of the older content such as past Battle of Broxton Bridge info and the Bee camp flag-raising. I changed the background on the Snowden site to have a white background. The other glitch is that folders are "case sensitive" like passwords. I don't know how that affects visitors to the site. I have tried to go back into the SCOCR website, look at every link, on every page, and retype the link to match the case of the folder. This took a very long time, and then I had to upload the pages on which I made changes.

If you are on any of the websites for which I am webmaster, and you cannot reach a link, please try clicking your browser back button, then click the refresh button, and click the link again. If it still does not work, please send me an email that includes both the page you were clicking from and the link you were trying to reach. I can't fix problems until I know where they are. Thanks for your help.
